122. Ph.D Scholars and Pharm.D students from Department of Pharmacy Practice, attended a



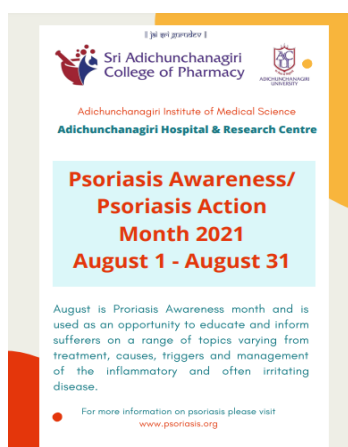

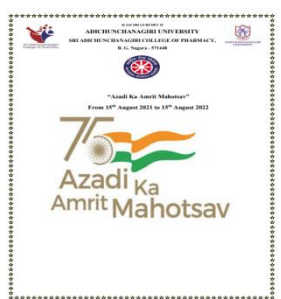


ACU Planning, Monitoring & Evaluation Board meeting.
