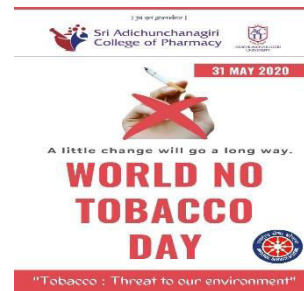
Events Reports (18th May – 25th June 2022)

- 12) On 6th June 2022, AICTE, Ministry of Education, launched a new scheme named as "ABCDEFGHI" in



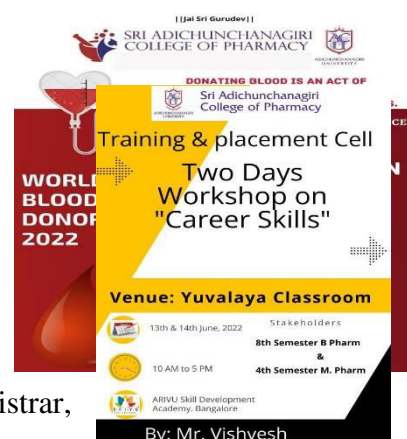

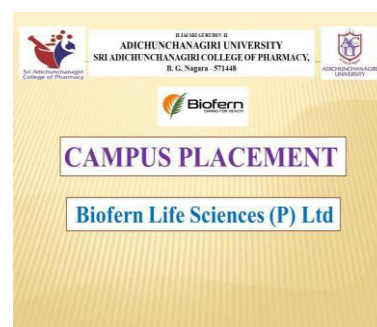

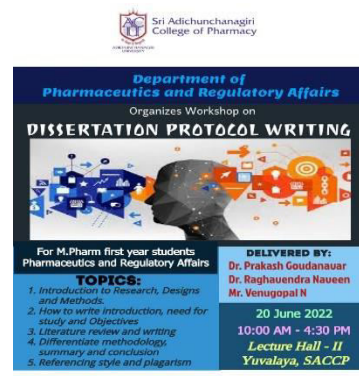


Supply Chain, Micro Labs Limited, emphasized on Pharma MBA and how Business development and Supply Chain Integrity works in pharmaceutical companies.

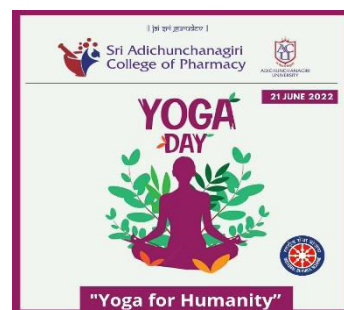

25) International Yoga Day was celebrated at BGS stadium, ACU campus, B G Nagara.

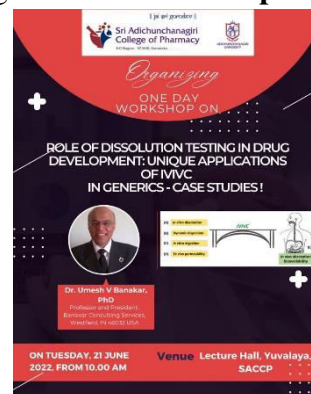

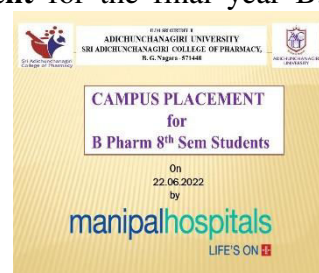

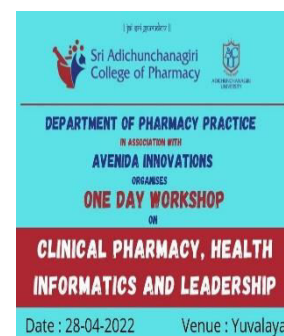
- 1) World creativity and innovation day 2022 was observed by distributing the digital pamphlet on social media on 21st April 2022.
